# **Second Call for Delegate**

### 1. Background

- ASEAN(Association of Southeast Asian Nations) and Korea established AKCF(ASEAN-ROK Cooperation Fund) in 1990 to promote collaboration and cooperation, human resource development, cultural and academic exchanges.
- Asia Exchange Association(AEA) has been sponsored by ASEAN-ROK Cooperation Fund(AKCF) since 2010 to build up a cooperative network through non-governmental exchanges among young people and hosted AKFF for co-prosperity of ASEAN and Korea.
- AKFF has followed ROP(Rules of Procedure) of MUN(Model United Nations) for Model Summit, drawn a collaborative plan for ASEAN and Korea through several times of discussions, and supported the Youth of ASEAN and Korea to be a global leader for driving next-generation.
- AKFF marked 9<sup>th</sup> event in 2020 and has moved forward to host multi-year projects including sectoral forums to pursue project continuity; build networking between participants and promote in-depth discussion for the agenda in the Socio-Culture; Political- Security; and Economic Sector. - Jan. 2020: Model ASEAN-Korea Summit(MAKS), Busan
  - Nov. 2021: ASEAN-Korea Political-Security Forum(AKPSF), Busan
  - Jul. 2022: ASEAN-Korea Socio-Culture Forum, Ministry of Education Cambodia(Expected)
  - Jul. 2022: ASEAN-Korea Economic Forum(AKEF), Busan(July 22 to 29)
  - Dec. 2022: ASEAN-Korea Alumni, Seoul(Expected)
